Sir :-

I herewith submit the Quarterly Return of
the Holy Angels Indian Residential School for the Quarter
ended June 30. The following remarks complete it :

1. The Primary Classroom was open 45.5 days during the quarter;
the Intermediate Classroom ... 44.5 days;
the Senior Classroom 44 days.
2. The classrooms re-opened after Easter on the 8th of April.
3. From the 11th to the 28th of April, the three classrooms
were closed by order of the District Nurse on account of an
epidemic of flu. Many day scholars, all the pupils resident
at the school and several members of the staff fell within
the first four days, but all were able to resume their tasks
after two weeks.
4. In June, four days were allowed for the cutting of potato
seed and the planting.
